Entrance for Visitors

During the week of the Davos WEF 2019, the entrance will be open especially for you from 9.00 am through 6.00 pm! Pictures of the signs and the site are published on our website!

Security Check

All visitors MUST pass the security check

Please deposit large bags or luggage in the hold at the "Service Center" or in one of the lockers near the entrance. Dangerous goods are not allowed. Photos and films of the facilities at the security check are not allowed.

Ramp Tour Tickets

Prepaid reservations are being confirmed by email. Requests for reallocation of reservations before Saturday 11th, January 2020 (only if possible) are being charged with an extra fee of CHF 10.-- The organizers reserve the right to cancel any individual or all tours at very short notice against a refund of CHF 29.-- per ticket.

Start of the Special Ramp Tours

Please come next to the "Rundfahrtenkasse" on Observation Deck B ten minutes before your scheduled departure. Come forward to our desk and tell us your name. We will check and tick off your paid reservation. Before boarding the coach, yellow airport safety jackets will be distributed, which you have to return to us at the end of the tour. At the departure time, Guards with orange safety jackets will guide you to your bus.

Special Ramp Tour Description

The two hours special day ramp tour for a maximum of 45 aviation enthusiasts starts and ends at the Observation Deck B. The two hours special night ramp tour will be restricted to 20 aviation enthusiasts and starts at the same place (tripods allowed). No unaccompanied minors under the age of 14 are accepted.

There are only a few seats available on each ramp tour bus, be prepared to stand and walk for two hours! Each bus comes with a driver, two tour guides, two to three guards and a representative of BuchAIR Tours, equipped with air band receiver, internal walkie-talkies, whistle and megaphone. It is absolutely necessary that you follow the instructions of the tour guides and the guards in orange safety jackets. We drive you to the different parked aircraft and other sites, where you may disembark under supervision, take your pictures or note registrations quickly. Please bear in mind that there are many aircraft and you have only 120 minutes per tour! In some areas you may walk along line-ups. The guards will ask you to stay together and not to cross red lines, where indicated. Please make sure you dress appropriately for harsh winter conditions. Wear sturdy shoes to walk in snow, a good winter jacket and have a cap ready, just in case it starts snowing! Should you decide to stay inside the bus, while others get off, you may not deplane at short notice. See also "Airport Building Layout"
